### Guidance for Flash Talk Presenters

We are delighted you have been accepted for a Flash Talk at this year's conference. Flash Talks are a new addition this year and we expect them to be a high-energy highlight of the conference. To help you prepare and to ensure everything goes smoothly on the day, we have prepared the following guidance. Do let us know if you have any questions.

- Flash Talks will be for a strictly-timed 5 minute duration. A clock counting down from 5 minutes will be displayed on-screen throughout your talk to help you manage your time. You will not be permitted to overrun.
- There will be five Flash Talks delivered one after the other, with all presenters then answering questions in a joint 10 minute Q&A session afterwards.
- To ensure people are well-prepared we will ask you to submit a recording (audio or video) of you delivering your flash talk by **Monday 2 September** to [research@rcn.org.uk](mailto:research@rcn.org.uk) It's a great opportunity to practice!
- These talks are designed to give people an engaging overview of your work. Prepare well and avoid cramming in too much! One of the great things about a flashtalk is that lots of people will see it. Those who are particularly interested in your work are likely to seek you out during the conference to hear more 😊

A maximum of 3 presentation slides.

Recommended font size:

- Titles should be 36-44 pt.
- Font size for all other text should be a minimum of 24-28 pt.
