### IS Leadership Challenge 30 April 2024

The Leadership Challenge took place at Queen's University Belfast and was attended by nurses from various healthcare settings, including nursing homes, nursing agencies, school nursing and hospices. The one-day event involved immersive participation in four scenarios, each introducing additional challenges throughout the day.

Participants were placed in teams and remained in those teams throughout the event. Each team was evaluated in the scenario by the judges and there was further team evaluation based on a presentation at the end of the day. The objective of the leadership challenge was to simulate a Cyberattack on a healthcare facility, allowing participants to assess the adaptability of their leadership skills in a crisis and their ability to prioritise patient and staff safety in a safe environment and with a person-centred approach.
